The activity focused approach of Challenge games creates a non-threatening, cooperative environment to learn about group dynamics while participants learn how to listen to each other, value and build on the strengths inherent in differences. Challenge provides participants the foundation for sustained teamwork and problem solving.

This three day training will introduce teen leaders, teachers, counselors and recreational staff to the highly adaptable theories and the games of “portable challenge.” This methodology of experiential games for building cooperation and teamwork is supported by evidence-based practices. Individuals have the opportunity to develop greater self-efficacy and communication skills.

Participants are eligible for ongoing mentoring in the WSU Challenge program.
