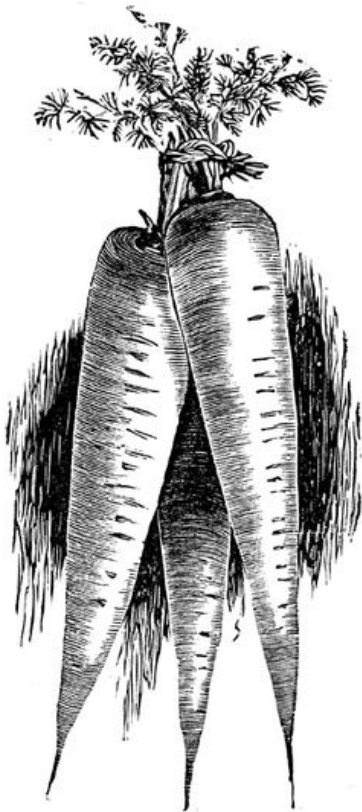
12-week training runs February 2019 – April 2019
